

Call for papers - for JLSP no. 9 (March 2022)

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The studies are **double-blind peer reviewed** and fall into one of the following **categories**: state-of-art articles, methodological studies, conceptual articles, original research reports, case studies.

The **languages** of the papers are – according to the object of each study – English, French, German or Italian.

The recommended **length** for a study is between 8 and 10 pages, though longer contributions can be accepted if justified. The [instructions for authors](#) provide the template **format** that shall be used for editing the papers for submission.

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
